

MINUTES
BUDGET WORK SESSION
MAY 11, 2006

The Aberdeen Board of Commissioners met Thursday, May 11, 2006 at 5:30 p.m. for a Budget Work Session for the purpose of reviewing proposed FY2006-2007 budget. Members present were Mayor Elizabeth Mofield and Commissioners Pat Ann McMurray, Robbie Farrell, Arthur Parker and Donna Shannon. Commissioner Walter Wright was unable to attend due to being out of town. Others in attendance were Mr. Bob Stafford, Steve Guyton, Scott Matthews, Town Attorney Michael Brough and Matthew Moriarity, Reporter for the Pilot.

Mayor Mofield called the Budget Work Session to order. She stated the Board needed to go into Closed Session for the purpose of Attorney-Client privilege. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parker, seconded by Commissioner Farrell, to go into Closed Session for the purpose of Attorney-Client privilege. Motion unanimously carried.

The Board returned from the Closed Session to the Open Session. Mayor Mofield then directed comments to Mr. Bob Stafford stating the Board appreciated all that he had done for Aberdeen and that the Town was excited about this subdivision being developed. She stated she was sorry that there was a difference in the interpretation of the open space requirements and the Board would still like to see some additional recreational area within this development. She then informed Mr. Stafford that Preliminary Plat Review PLP#06-02 had been approved as submitted.

The Board then began the Budget Work Session. Finance Officer Beth Wentland distributed to the members of the Board a copy of the proposed FY2006-2006 Budget for their review and discussion. Manager Zell asked the Board to further review the budget and there would be a question-and-answer session at the next Budget Work Session scheduled for Thursday, May 25th at 5:30 p.m.

A motion was then made by Commissioner Parker, seconded by Commissioner Farrell, to adjourn the Budget Work Session. Motion unanimously carried.
