METHOD OF COMPLIANCE *(check all applicable) :*

- The pool will be equipped with a powered safety cover in compliance with ASTM F-1346.
- The pool will be equipped with an approved safety pool cover complying with ASTM F-1346.
- The pool will be isolated from access from the dwelling and yard by an enclosure meeting the barrier requirements of Section AG105 of the NC Residential Code 2012
- Combination of a partial barrier, wall of a dwelling serving as a partial barrier, alarms and/or self closing/latching devices:
 - Doors with direct access to the pool through that wall shall be equipped with an alarm which produces an audible warning when the door and/or its screen, if present, are opened. The alarm shall be listed and labeled in accordance with UL 2017. The deactivation switch(es) shall be located at least 54 inches (1372 mm) above the threshold of the door. (AG 105.2/9.2)
 - All doors providing direct access from the dwelling to the pool must be equipped with a self-closing, self-latching device with mechanical latching/locking installed a minimum 54 inches above the threshold, which is acceptable to the authority have jurisdiction so long the degree of protection afforded is not less than the afforded protection described above.
 - Suction outlets shall be designed and installed in accordance with ANSI/APSP-7. (AG 106.1)

NOTE : Inspection access to the interior of the dwelling is required if alarms on windows and doors or if self-closing/self latching doors are utilized to meet the above requirements.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT : I hereby certify that I will need a safety barrier installed in accordance with the North Carolina State Residential Building Code and all inspection approvals, including final inspection, will be obtained. The 2012 North Carolina State Residential Building Code required private pool to be enclosed by a barrier meeting the requirements of Appendix G. Residential Swimming Pools, Spas and Hot Tubs must meet at least of the the safety barrier requirements, as indicated above.
